JANUARY IS THYROID AWARENESS MONTH

THYROID CANCER

A CANCER ON THE RISE

Thyroid cancer is a cancerous tumor or growth (nodule) located within the thyroid gland is uncommon, accounting for only about 1 out of every 100 cancers in the United States. For reasons that are not quite clear, the incidence of thyroid cancer in women is rising faster than any other cancer in the United States. Some think that the rising incidence is due to the accidental detection and early diagnosis of very small thyroid cancers with widespread use of radiology studies of the head and neck. Other researchers are worried that there is as yet some unknown cause for the rise in thyroid cancer cases.

Usually the specific cause of an individual patient's thyroid cancer isn't known. Thyroid cancer is more likely to occur on people who have undergone radiation therapy of the head, neck or chest during childhood. Radiation was commonly used before 1960 to shrink enlarged tonsils or adenoids, to treat various skin problems (such as acne), and to reduce enlarged thymus gland (an organ inside the chest) in infants. Radiation exposure following the Chernobyl nuclear power plant reactor tragedy resulted in more than 5,000 cases of thyroid cancer in children exposed to the fallout in April 1986.

Radiation that is used in diagnostic X-rays (e.g. X-rays used by dentists or CT scans of the neck/chest) is probably not connected with thyroid cancer. However; radiation treatments to the head and neck that are still being used as therapy for malignancies in childhood and early adult life can be associated with an increased risk of development of thyroid cancer many years later. Thyroid cancer is also more likely to occur if you have a family member who has had thyroid cancer. However, thyroid cancer can occur in anyone.
